Housing Stability

Payee Services



We assist those individuals whose physical or mental illness restricts their ability to manage their own money. The counselor will:

- + Develop and implement a personal budget to pay client's expenses;
- + Advocate on behalf of client with creditors to ensure payment of debts and bills;
- + Assist clients in acquiring services such as SNAP benefits, Medicaid and Lifeline.

Who is eligible? Any person receiving Social Security benefits and/or VA benefits who is deemed disabled, or unable to manage their personal finances.

Homeless Prevention



Services include permanent supportive housing to chronically homeless individuals, permanent housing for individuals who are clients of Charleston-Dorchester Mental Health Center, as well as supportive services and temporary financial assistance to homeless veterans. We assist individuals with additional financial coaching and wrap-around services.

One Less Homeless Vet



We provide start-up home supplies for low-income veterans in the Charleston Tri-County area. The newly housed referred veteran takes our budgeting course and registers at a local retail partner store. Once we approve and pay for the registry items, they are delivered to the veteran's new home. Participants receive necessities such as pots and pans, towels, a microwave, mattress set, sheets, etc. Learn more about this specific program at onelesshomelessvet.org.

Referrals



Clients are referred by the local Social Security Administration, Dept. of Mental Health, Adult/Child Protective Services, human services agencies, homeless shelters, law offices, courts, hospitals, friends, and relatives.



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
